The health Sciences School of the Polytechnic Institute of Leiria is organizing the 1st Nursing Students International Congress that will take place on the 26th and 27th February of 2016.

This Congress, with the theme ‘**Nurses Worldwide**’, has the goal to promote the scientific discussion within the transcultural/multicultural nursing care, to discuss professional, ethical and legal questions within the transcultural/multicultural nursing care and to stimulate the national and international scientific disclosure.

In the context of globalization, the experience of contact with other cultures began to be a frequent practice in the multiple forms of contact: through mobility, in long and short-stay tourism, in the forced emigration and volunteers in political exiles and refugees of war and poverty. The provision of culturally appropriate care is an ethical obligation of nurses, and the development of skills/abilities and attitudes in cross-cultural/multicultural nursing care will allow for individualized and appropriate care to each person.

|Submissions

Rules for the abstracts submission:

With the purpose of sharing your ideas, investigations and experiences about health, as well as contributing to the development of practices, education and investigation in nursing, we would like to invite you to participate in this scientific event.

Submit your summaries to the 1st International Congress of Nursing Students, through the following [submissions form](#).

The work must be consistent with one of the following Congress topics:

Congress Topics:

- Portuguese Nursing Worldwide
- The Multicultural Care in Portugal
- Autonomy and Clinical Decision Making

Congress Subtopics:

- Nursing and multiculturalism
- Nurses Mental health and transculturality
- Family relationships at a distance
- Multicultural formation in nursing
- Emigration politics in nursing
- The minority care
- Taking care of the families of the ones who leave
- Communicating with immigrants
- Nurses integration into work contexts
- Globalization, culture, ethnicity and professional identity
- Transcultural nursing care
- Others

Abstract submission:

- Abstracts can be submitted in Portuguese, Spanish or English
- Abstracts are submitted electronically through the submissions form
- Abstracts must be original and maximum 250 words including: Introduction, Objectives, Methods, Results and Conclusions
- Abstracts are published in an eBook by authors authorization
- All received abstracts are reviewed by two double blind reviewers
- The authors are responsible for the content of their presentations
- One of the authors will be the communication speaker, as indicated in the application form, and should make his registration and payment until the deadline
- The work will only be considered to entry in the program if the registration is made and paid
- Each registered participant cannot present more than two communications
- The author that presents the communication must make his registration in the congress through the signup sheet until 48 hours before the event
- Each communication must have at least one author registered in the Congress

Deadlines:

- Deadline for abstracts submission: 31st January 2016
- Result's Communication: 8th January 2016

Your participation can assume one of the following **formats:**

Oral communication:

- Authors must indicate the main theme of their communication and the theme that should focus on the proposed subtopics
- Each abstract can only be submitted to one of the main themes
- The Scientific and Organizing Committee of the Congress can suggest the changing of the topic
- This format is limited to a 10 minute presentation and a 5 minute discussion
- The slides for the presentation should be in Portuguese, Spanish or English
- In case of acceptance, if the author presenting the communication is not the first author of the abstract, the authors should expressly indicate which element will be presenting the communication, wherein each author can present a maximum two abstracts (poster and/or oral) in the Congress
- The author that presents the communication should make his registration in the Congress

Poster Communication:

- The authors should indicate in which of the subtopics their communication fits
- It won't be necessary another type of presentation

- The poster presentation shouldn't exceed 3 minutes, wherein the poster will be presented in paper format with 80 centimetres width x 110 centimetres height, being exposed at a location to define
- The Scientific and Organizing Committee of the Congress can suggest the changing of the topic
- The posters are arranged in paper format and presented orally
- The poster should be presented in Portuguese, Spanish or English
- The poster should be delivered on the first day in the secretariat
- The oral presentation of the posters is limited to 3 minutes and 2 minutes of discussion
- In case of acceptance, if the author presenting the communication is not the first author of the abstract, the authors should expressly indicate which element will be presenting the communication, wherein each author can present a maximum two abstracts (poster and/or oral) in the Congress
- The author the presents the communication should make his registration in the Congress

Prizes:

- A prize will be awarded to the best oral communication and to the best poster communication, at the closing ceremony of the Congress
- When submitting the abstract, the authors should sign if they want or not to apply to the prize

Presentation certificates:

- It will be released a certificate to all presented communications
- The communication certificate will be given by default to the first author of the abstract or to the indicated presenter in the submissions form
- The certificate will have the presenter definition and also the discrimination of the abstract authors
